The Stoller Hall is a brand new, purpose built 482 seat concert hall with state-of-the-art design, acoustics and facilities. Designed by Stephenson Studios with specialist consultants Arup Acoustics, The Stoller Hall is one of the finest examples of modern concert auditorium design.

Situated directly opposite Manchester Victoria station, The Stoller Hall is perfectly located for local, regional and national access. Visitors enter via the stunning Oglesby Atrium which also serves the Carole Nash Hall, our smaller 100 seat sister venue. The Stoller Hall is the ideal place for recitals, chamber concerts, jazz, folk, pop and spoken word events as well as recordings and conferences.



STAGE

Dimensions

Standard W 14m x D 8.5m (approx.)

Extension W 14m x D 12.5m (approx.)

Risers

Two fully automated upstage choir/orchestral risers plus stage extension riser.

SEATING

Maximum Capacity 482

Stalls 354

Balcony 45

Gallery 83

Seat Holds

The stage extension removes 90 seats from the front of the Stalls

The mixing desk removes six seats from the rear of the Stalls

Eight House Seats are held for all shows and released on sale if not required

Wheelchairs

Several wheelchair positions are available, which are interchangeable with standard seating. It is our policy to offer one free companion seat alongside tickets purchased through our Access Scheme.

AUDITORIUM

Air Handling

Silent air displacement system with thermostatically controlled heating and cooling

Acoustic Banners

Automated banners located on three sides of the auditorium and acoustic curtain on back wall create an acoustically flexible space for different types of performance

Hearing Loop

Infrared hearing loop broadcast in auditorium

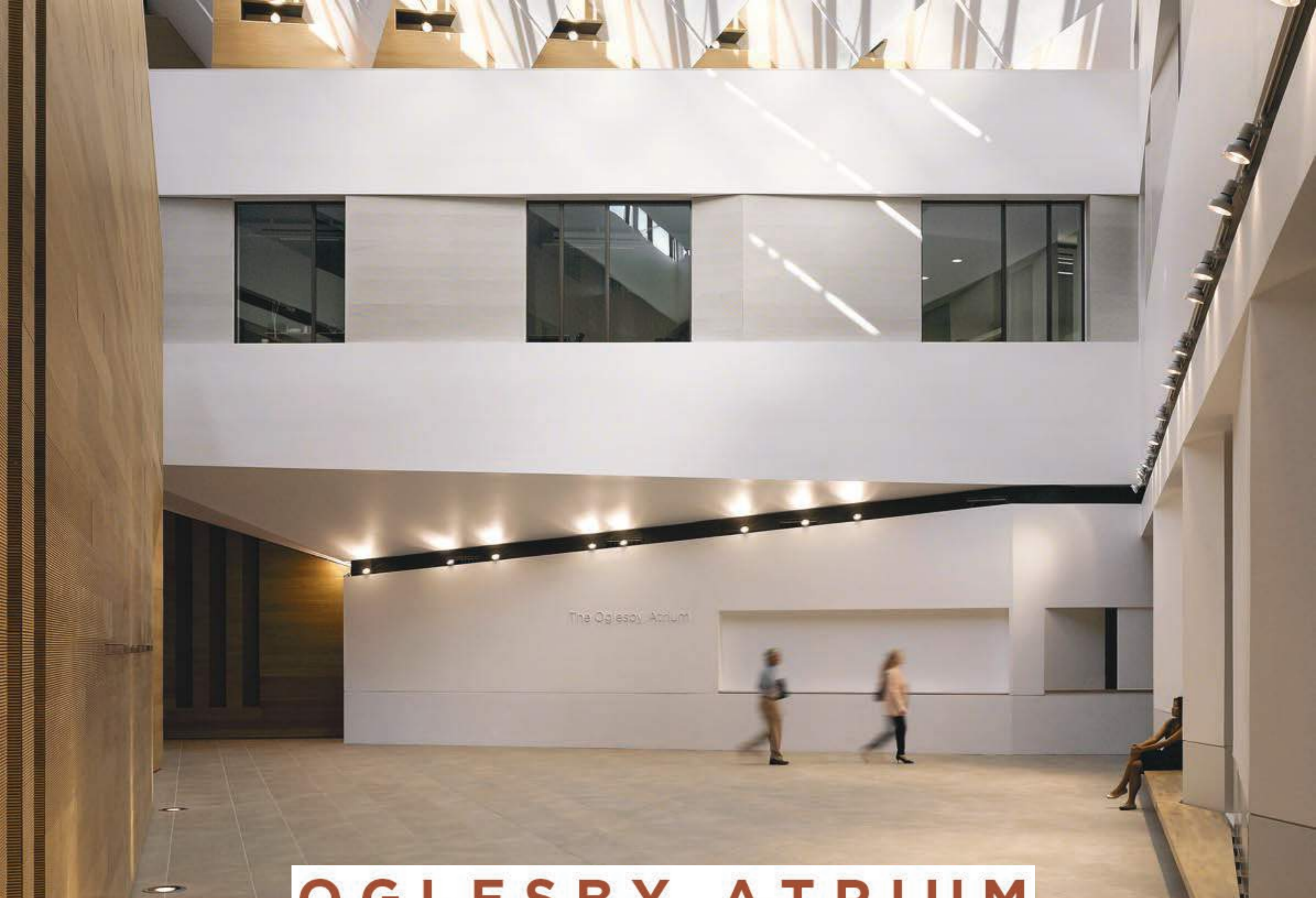
